

**Concrete Couch Summer Internship Program Application for  
“SUMMER COYOTE” (Formally the SCAMP program)**

**Summer Coyote:** This is a camp composed of five week-long projects. The camp is free and open to kids and adults. Participants learn skills, make friends, and contribute to our community.

**Internship:** Interns will assist in running Summer Coyote. They will learn basic job skills, while exploring: teaching, construction, art, environmental, and community building skills. This is a volunteer internship; however, second year interns receive a stipend.

**Schedule:** June 3 through August 2 (see full schedule on SUMMER COYOTE flyer).

Camps run Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to noon each day.

Interns will attend 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. (Fridays will go until 1pm for a debrief of the week.)

Each project is followed by an “off” week where the intern is 100% free of SCAMP work.

Intern orientation dinner: Tuesday **May 21, 6-730pm** 214 East Vermijo Avenue, CS 80903.

Debrief dinner: Wednesday **August 7, 6-730pm** 214 East Vermijo Avenue, CS 80903.

**Projects:** To include trail and stone retaining wall building; wood construction for benches and other structures; environmental restoration work, soil building, and planting; art and design to include hand building with clay, painting, and ceramic and glass mosaics; nature observation, water quality testing, and collecting data on fauna and flora; and music and parades.

**Locations:** 1100 S. Royer Street (Corner of Royer and Las Vegas), property recently purchased by Concrete Couch. This will be the first summer of activation programs on the site.

**Facilities:** We will have a porta-potty, shade structures, and hand washing water on site. Interns should come ready to be outside and to keep themselves comfortable and safe in this setting (for example: bringing water bottles, sunscreen, extra clothes, snacks, etc).

**Intern qualifications:** We are seeking interns who are motivated, energetic, and who want to learn. Interns must be 15 years or older, and be able to work 4 of the 5 program weeks, and attend one of the 3 “Second Saturday Skillshares” at the CC office.

**Applying:** Prospective interns should send an e-mail to Kendall at [kendall@concretecouch.org](mailto:kendall@concretecouch.org) with a resume and/or a letter of why you want to take part in the internship, by MAY 10. We require an interview to be accepted into the program.
